IN RE: HB3982 by Romero, Jr. (Relating to solicitation of a person to buy drinks for consumption by an alcoholic beverage retailer or the retailer's employee; authorizing a civil penalty; amending a provision that is subject to a criminal penalty.), Committee Report 1st House, Substituted

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Alcoholic Beverage Code as it relates to solicitation of a person to buy drinks for consumption by a retailer or a retailer's employee and regarding alternatives to license or permit suspension. The Alcoholic Beverage Commission has determined that the bill would not result in a significant fiscal impact to the State. The bill would take effect September 1, 2015.
