**IN RE: HB3991** by Allen (Relating to the committee developing a student's individualized education plan, the written report of the committee, and a regular education teacher's opportunity for input into a student's individualized education plan.), **As Introduced** 

#### No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would require a school district to develop a process for a teacher instructing a student with a disability in a regular classroom setting to provide input into the student's individualized education plan (IEP).

The bill would require the admission, review, and dismissal (ARD) committee to develop a written report documenting the meeting.

The bill would have no direct fiscal implications for the Foundation School Program (FSP) or the operations of the Texas Education Agency (TEA).

## **Local Government Impact**

A district would be required to develop a process for a teacher instructing a student with a disability in a regular classroom setting to provide input into the students IEP. Districts would also be required to produce a written report of the ARD committee meeting. Costs to districts to prepare the written report cannot be determined.
