**IN RE: HB4122** by Davis, Yvonne (Relating to retroactive child support sought after a child reaches 18 years of age.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Family Code to provide that a parent may not seek retroactive child support after the child is eighteen, unless the child is enrolled in school and is in compliance with attendance requirements, or has a disability. Based on the analysis of the Office of Court Administration, duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.
