IN RE: SB69 by Ellis (Relating to a notification requirement if a public school campus or openenrollment charter school does not have a nurse assigned to the campus during all instructional hours.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would require a public school or open-enrollment charter school that did not have a full-time nurse assigned to it for more than 30 consecutive instructional days to provide written notice of this fact to each student's parent or guardian. A school could satisfy the notice requirement by posting the notice on the school's Internet website.

Local Government Impact
