IN RE: SB166 by Lucio (Relating to the jurisdiction and powers of and the referral of certain proceedings to a criminal law hearing officer in Cameron County.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Government Code relating to criminal law hearing offices in Cameron County.

The Office of Court Administration reported no significant impact to the state court system is anticipated.
