IN RE: SB291 by Nelson (Relating to the jurisdiction of a county court at law in Tarrant County.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Government Code to expand the jurisdiction of certain courts in Tarrant County to include appeals from a municipal court of record in the county that is not an appeal of a criminal case or proceeding.

The Office of Court Administration reported no significant impact to the state court is anticipated.
