No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Government Code to provide that, upon request of the State Judicial Conduct Commission (SCJC), a court reporter shall provide to the commission at no cost a backup audio recording of a court proceeding if one has been made. The Office of Court Administration indicates no significant fiscal implication to the court system is anticipated.
