IN RE: SB652 by Schwertner (Relating to excluding a franchisor as an employer of a franchisee or a franchisee's employees.), Committee Report 2nd House, Substituted

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

This bill would amend the Labor Code relating to excluding a franchisor as an employer of a franchisee or a franchisee's employees. Based on information provided by the Texas Workforce Commission and the Texas Department of Insurance, it is assumed that duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.
