IN RE: SB794 by Hancock (Relating to the authority of a political subdivision to issue debt to purchase or lease tangible personal property.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Government Code to prohibit a political subdivision from issuing a public security to purchase or lease tangible personal property if the expected life of the property ends before the maturity date of the public security.
