**IN RE:** SB907 by Perry (Relating to the powers and duties of the board of regents of the Texas Tech University System and to workers' compensation coverage for employees of the system's components.), **As Introduced**

The bill amends various sections of the Education Code and Labor Code as they relate to the powers and duties of the board of regents of the Texas Tech University System and to workers' compensation coverage for employees of the system's components. Texas Tech University System would implement provisions of the bill within existing resources.
