IN RE: SB1073 by Zaffirini (Relating to the provision of a candidate's campaign mailing address and electronic mail address in the candidate's application for a place on the ballot.), As **Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Elections Code by requiring candidates for elected offices to provide certain information and its availability.

The Secretary of State indicates the provisions of the bill could be implemented within existing resources.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2015.
