IN RE: SB1117 by Zaffirini (Relating to housing services provided through the transitional living services program to certain children in the conservatorship of the Department of Family and Protective Services.), **As Engrossed**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend Chapter 264 of the Family Code to require the Department of Family and Protective Services to expand a youth's transitional plan to assist the youth in managing housing needs after leaving foster care.
