IN RE: SB1308 by Menéndez (Relating to veterans services information provided to veterans who receive driver's licenses and personal identification certificates.), Committee Report 1st House, Substituted

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Transportation Code to require the Department of Public Safety and the Texas Veterans Commission to develop and issue a one-page informational paper about veterans services provided by the state to a veteran who receives a driver's license or personal identification certificate with a veteran's designation. It is assumed any costs associated with implementing the bill could be absorbed within current resources.
