IN RE: SB1436 by Zaffirini (Relating to the setback requirements for a junkyard or an automotive wrecking and salvage yard; amending provisions subject to a criminal penalty.), **Committee Report 2nd House, Substituted**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Transportation Code to prohibit a junkyard or an automotive wrecking and salvage yard to be located within 50 feet of the nearest property line of a residence.

Local Government Impact

There could be an increase in fine revenue to municipalities due to the provisions of the bill. No significant fiscal impact is anticipated.
