IN RE: SB1502 by Garcia (Relating to county regulation of the removal and storage of unlawfully stopped motor vehicles; authorizing counties to require an occupational license or permit and impose a fee for the license or permit.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Transportation Code to permit a commissioners court by order to license or grant a permit to an individual to remove an unlawfully stopped vehicle in an unincorporated area of the county. The bill provides for the rules and requirements of an order.
