**IN RE:** SB1532 by Burton (Relating to the appointment of an associate commissioner for veterans services at the Health and Human Services Commission.), **As Engrossed**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Government Code to require that the executive commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) appoint an associate commissioner for veterans services. Based on the analysis provided by HHSC, the Commission currently has an associate commissioner for veterans services; therefore, the bill can be implemented within existing resources.
