IN RE: SB1575 by Rodríguez (Relating to county regulation of lots in platted subdivisions that have remained undeveloped for 25 years or more.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to permit a commissioners court to create a process to regulate subdivision lots that have been undeveloped for 25 years or more.
