IN RE: SB1628 by Taylor, Larry (Relating to insurance claims and certain prohibited acts and practices in or in relation to the business of insurance.), **Committee Report 2nd House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Insurance Code relating to insurance claims and certain prohibited acts and practices in or in relation to the business of insurance.

Based on information provided by the Texas Department of Insurance and the Office of Court Administration, this analysis assumes that all duties and responsibilities necessary to implement the provisions of the bill could be accomplished utilizing existing staff and resources.
