**IN RE:** SB1697 by Huffman (relating to the confidentiality of certain information regarding procedures and substances used in the execution of a convict.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Government Code and Code of Criminal Procedure as they relate to the confidentiality of certain information, as described by the bill, regarding the execution of a convict. The bill would take effect immediately upon receiving a two-thirds majority vote in each house, otherwise the bill would take effect September 1, 2015.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
