**IN RE:** **SB1780** by Menéndez (Relating to the administration of rabies vaccine under a local rabies control program.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to authorize certain veterinarians, who do not have a veterinarian-client-patient relationship with an animal, to administer or supervise the administration of a rabies vaccine.
