**IN RE:** SB1934 by Campbell (Relating to requirements for the issuance of a driver's license or personal identification certificate.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Transportation Code to stipulate how the Department of Public Safety may request and use a driver license applicant's social security number, and would apply the same standards to personal identification cards. The bill would require an individual to surrender their identification card to get a driver license, and their driver license to get an identification card. It is assumed implementing the provisions of the bill could be absorbed within existing resources.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
