IN RE: SB1950 by Hinojosa (Relating to the fee imposed on certain property owners by a county for the establishment of street lights along a county road.), Committee Report 2nd House, Substituted

## No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Transportation Code to permit a commissioners court of a county to adopt an order that may provide for the collection of a fee imposed by the county tax-assessor. Under the provisions of the bill, a county tax assessor collector would be required to include a fee in a tax bill for each landowner who has benefited from the street lights. The bill provides requirements for the tax bill.

## **Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
