







Pursuant to Section 57, Article III of the Texas Constitution and the House and Senate Rules, Montgomery County Hospital District which provides certain health care and other public services in Montgomery County, Texas, publishes this notice that it intends to file a local bill for consideration by the members of the 84th Texas Legislature meeting in Austin, Texas. If adopted the bill will amend section 1063.112 Special Districts Local Laws Code to raise the threshold level for submitting construction contracts to a competitive procurement process from \$10,000 to \$50,000.
