


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
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**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO INTRODUCE A BILL
IN THE LEGISLATURE OF TEXAS**

Notice is hereby given of the intention to introduce a bill in the Regular Session of the 84th Session of the Legislature of the State of Texas annexing territory into the Harris County Improvement District No. 17 (the "District"), the territory of which will be partially located within the extra territorial limits of the City of Houston, partially within Harris County, and partially within Montgomery County. The district was initially created as a special district under and pursuant to the provisions of Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and pursuant to the power of the Legislature to create special government agencies and districts for the purposes of constructing, financing and operating public infrastructure and improvements within and outside the district and promoting the economic development of the State of Texas, Harris County, the City of Houston, and neighboring communities.

HCID 17 ANNEXATION GENERAL BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION

HARRIS COUNTY:

Tract 1 (FM 2920 at Telge Rd.) is +/- 117 acre tract located southwest of intersection of FM 2920 (Waller-Tomball) and Telge Roads, in northwest Harris County and City of Houston ETJ.

Tract 2 (Decker Prairie Rosehill) is +/- 99 acre tract located at 22414 Decker Prairie-Rosehill Rd. (southeast corner of Decker Prairie-Rosehill and Nutty Farms Roads), in northwest Harris County and City of Houston ETJ.

Tract 3 (Broze Road at FM 1960) is +/- 111 acre tract located at northeast intersection of Broze and FM 1960 (Humble Westfield) Roads in north central Harris County and City of Houston ETJ.

MONTGOMERY COUNTY:

Tract 4 (Community Estates) is +/- 134 acre tract located north of the intersection FM 1488 and Community Roads in southwest Montgomery County and east of City of Magnolia.

Tract 5 (Colony at Pinehurst) is +/- 163 acre tract located northwest of the intersection FM 149 and FM 1774 Roads in southwest Montgomery County and west of the Pinehurst Community.

Tract 6 (Hardin Store Rd.) is +/- 104 acre tract located at the intersection of Hardin Store and Virgie Community Roads in southwest Montgomery County near Decker Prairie Community.

Tract 7 (Adjacent to Enclave at Dobbin) is +/- 24 acre tract located south of the intersection of Hardin Store and Clint-Neidig Roads in southwest Montgomery County.

Tract 8 (Enclave at Dobbin) is +/- 66 acre tract located northwest of intersection of Carraway Lane and Dobbin-Hufsmith Roads in southwest Montgomery County.

Tract 9 (Black Oak) is +/- 162 acre tract located near the intersection of Dry Creek and Standard Roads in southwest Montgomery County.
