



trial will be delayed until
10 a.m. Monday because
of weather and could be
put off for the day.

"As soon as I did it, I knew I'd
made a mistake," Routh told
Dunn. "I thought, 'This isn't go-
ing to look good.'"

Defense attorney Alan Nash,
who has been helped in the case
by Assistant Attorney General
Jane Starnes, put their own ex-
perts on the witness stand to tes-
tify that Routh suffered from
psychosis caused by alcohol and
marijuana abuse, and that he
was not legally insane.

Television influences

Dr. Randall Price, a forensic
psychologist who frequently tes-
tifies in capital murder cases,
said he did not believe Routh was
schizophrenic, and he blamed
his psychosis on voluntary
abuse, mostly of marijuana.

Price told jurors that Routh
may have formulated the stories
about "pig assassins" by watch-
ing *Seinfeld* and *Boss Hog* from
his jail cell. A 1993 episode of
Seinfeld includes a segment
about "pig people," and Disco-
very's *Boss Hog* features a char-
acter called Pigman.

Dr. Michael Arambula, a fo-
rensic psychiatrist who serves as
president of the Texas Medical

State District Judge Jason
Cashon has indicated jurors will
likely be sequestered once they
begin deliberating.

The deliberation could take
days, depending on how closely
the jury reviews the evidence
and testimony.

And the jury must reach a
unanimous decision — just one
juror with a different opinion
could cause a hung jury, which

would result in a mistrial.

"The jurors are very serious,"
Snipes said. "When you get a re-
ally serious case like this, they are
going to worry about it and fret
about it and worry about the im-
pact it is going to have for the rest
of their lives.

"And they should."
