







**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO INTRODUCE A BILL  
IN THE LEGISLATURE OF TEXAS**

Notice is hereby given of the intention to introduce in the Regular Session of the 84th Legislature of Texas a bill creating and establishing a special district to be known as Montgomery County Municipal Utility District No. 153, under the provisions of Article 16, Section 59 of the Constitution of Texas and pursuant to the inherent power of the Legislature to create special governmental agencies and districts, with powers including those given to municipal utility districts operating pursuant to Chapters 49 and 54, Texas Water Code, and including road powers under Article III, Section 52 of the Constitution of Texas. The bill will provide for the district's administration, powers, name, duties, operation, and financing.
