

**NOTICE OF INTENT
TO INTRODUCE A BILL**

Pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas, notice is hereby given of the intention to apply to the 84th Legislature of the State of Texas at its regular session in Austin, Texas for the introduction of a bill, the substance of the contemplated law being as follows:

An act relating to the creation of the FM 2920/Becker Road Municipal Utility District of Harris County; providing authority to impose a tax and issue bonds; granting a limited power of eminent domain.

The Act proposes to create a conservation and reclamation district to be known as FM 2920/Becker Road Municipal Utility District of Harris County, being approximately 143.175 acres in Harris County, Texas, more particularly described as follows:

Approximately 143.175 acres, made up of a single tract of land, located on or near the southwest corner of the intersection of FM 2920 and Becker Road, in Harris County, Texas.

The District's creation is subject to approval at a confirmation election.

All interested persons will, therefore, take notice of the matters and facts set out in the foregoing statement of the substance of the contemplated laws as required by the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas.
