Relating to the creation of a childhood health program grant.

Relating to the medical use of marihuana; providing a defense to prosecution for possession of marihuana.

Relating to the medical use of low-THC cannabis and the regulation of related organizations and individuals; requiring a dispensing organization to obtain a license to dispense low-THC cannabis and any employee of a dispensing organization to obtain a registration; authorizing fees.

HB 1174 Fletcher  
Relating to the types of medical professionals who may conduct an examination of certain school bus drivers.

HB 1952 Springer  
Relating to grants awarded by the Cancer Prevention and Research Institute of Texas.

HB 2240 Turner, Chris  
Relating to the public's ability to access the results of a hospital inspection, survey, or investigation conducted by the Department of State Health Services.

HB 2330 Zerwas | et al.  
Relating to the right of a dentist to contract for certain services.

HB 2503 Zerwas  
Relating to examination requirements for certain applicants for a license to practice medicine.

HB 2523 Collier | et al.  
Relating to the continuation of certain public benefits, including medical assistance, for individuals after release from confinement in a county jail.

HB 2748 Muñoz, Jr.  
Relating to warning signs for the sale of nitrous oxide; authorizing an administrative penalty.

HB 2908 Parker  
Relating to authorizing patients with certain terminal illnesses or severe chronic diseases to access certain investigational drugs, biological products, and devices that are in clinical trials.

HB 2978 Bonnen, Greg  
Relating to the licensing and regulation of neurodiagnostic technologists; requiring an occupational license; creating an offense; providing penalties and authorizing fees.

HB 3066 Coleman  
Relating to the regulation of the sale of dextromethorphan to minors; providing civil penalties.

HB 3445 Laubenberg  
Relating to implementing certain incentives and cost-sharing requirements under the Medicaid program.

HB 3473 Bonnen, Greg  
Relating to the provision of a cranial molding orthosis under the medical assistance and child health plan programs.

HB 3581 Sheffield  
Relating to the creation and maintenance of a registry of physicians co-managing patients with Licensees under Chapter 351, Occupations Code

HB 3651 Coleman  
Relating to the manufacture, sale, distribution, possession, and use of drugs not approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration and the false representation that a substance is a drug approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration; creating criminal offenses.

HB 3785 Márquez  
Relating to authorizing the possession, use, cultivation, distribution, transportation, and delivery of cannabis for medical purposes; authorizing fees.

Relating to identification and implementation of hospital funding solutions.

Relating to the exemption of certain persons from licensure as a professional counselor or social worker.
