Relating to water well drillers and pump installers; authorizing fees.

Relating to the sale and purchase of shark fins or products derived from shark fins; creating a criminal offense.

Relating to prohibiting camping and building fires in certain areas;
creating a criminal offense.

Relating to judicial review of final orders arising out of nutritional
programs administered by the Texas Department of Agriculture.

HB 4174 Reynolds SP: Ellis
Relating to the creation of a defined area in the Fort Bend County Water
Control and Improvement District No. 2; providing authority to issue
bonds; providing authority to impose assessments, fees, and taxes.

HB 4175 Thompson, Senfronia SP: Taylor, Larry
Relating to eminent domain powers of certain conservation and reclamation
districts.

HB 4187 Farney SP: Schwertner
Relating to renaming the Corn Hill Regional Water Authority as the Lone
Star Regional Water Authority; altering the governing body's membership.
