A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 42.002, Election Code, is amended by
6	amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
7	follows:
8	(a) The county election precincts are the election
9	precincts for the following elections:
10	(1) the general election for state and county
11	officers;
12	(2) a special election ordered by the governor;
13	(3) a primary election;
14	(4) a countywide election ordered by the commissioners
15	court, county judge, or other county authority, except an election
16	subject to Section 42.062(2); and
17	(5) as provided by Section 42.0621, any other election
18	held <u>by</u> [on the November uniform election date of] a political
19	subdivision on a uniform election date [, other than a district that
20	is created under Section 52, Article III, or Section 59, Article
21	XVI, Texas Constitution, and is located in a county with a
22	population of more than 3.3 million or a county adjacent to a county
23	with a population of more than 3.3 million].
24	(c) Subsection (a)(5) does not apply to an election held on

- 1 the May uniform election date by a political subdivision that:
- 2 (1) conducts early voting by personal appearance at
- 3 each permanent or temporary branch polling place on the same days
- 4 and during the same hours as voting is conducted at the main early
- 5 voting polling place; or
- 6 (2) has not established a permanent or temporary
- 7 <u>branch early voting polling place.</u>
- 8 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 42.0621, Election Code,
- 9 is amended to read as follows:
- 10 Sec. 42.0621. PRECINCTS FOR <u>ELECTIONS HELD ON A UNIFORM</u>
- 11 ELECTION DATE [NOVEMBER ELECTION].
- 12 SECTION 3. Section 42.0621(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 13 read as follows:
- 14 (a) In an election held on a [the November] uniform election
- 15 date, the political subdivisions to which Section 42.002(a)(5)
- 16 applies shall use the regular county election precincts.
- SECTION 4. Section 43.004(b), Election Code, is amended to
- 18 read as follows:
- 19 (b) If a political subdivision holds an election on a [the
- 20 November] uniform election date and is required to use the regular
- 21 county election precincts, the political subdivision shall
- 22 designate as the polling places for the election the regular county
- 23 polling places in the county election precincts that contain
- 24 territory from the political subdivision.
- 25 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
