Amend SB 17 (house committee report) as follows:

- (1) On page 2, line 5, between "<u>USE</u>" and the underlined period, insert "<u>AND DOMESTIC VIOLENCE</u>".
- (2) On page 2, lines 5 and 6, strike "The task force, in coordination with the department" and substitute "Using existing resources, the commission, in consultation with the task force".
- (3) On page 2, line 8, between "<u>use</u>" and "<u>screening</u>", insert "screening and domestic violence".
- (4) On page 2, line 11, between "use" and "using", insert "and verbally screening a pregnant woman for domestic violence".
- (5) On page 2, line 13, between "<u>treatment</u>" and "<u>resources</u>", insert "<u>resources</u> and domestic violence prevention and intervention".
- (6) On page 2, line 16, between "<u>use</u>" and "<u>during</u>", insert "and on domestic violence prevention and intervention".
- (7) On page 2, line 17, strike "department" and substitute "commission".
- (8) On page 2, line 19, strike "department's" and substitute "commission's".
- (9) On page 6, strike lines 17 through 19 and substitute the following:
- SECTION 8. Not later than June 1, 2018, the Health and Human Services Commission shall make
- (10) Add the following appropriately numbered SECTIONS to the bill and renumber subsequent SECTIONS of the bill accordingly:
- SECTION \_\_\_\_\_. Section 34.004, Health and Safety Code, is amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- (b) Meetings of the task force are [closed to the public and are not] subject to Chapter 551, Government Code, except that the task force may conduct a closed meeting to review cases under Section 34.007. A closed meeting conducted under this subsection is governed by Subchapter E, Chapter 551, Government Code.

## (c) The task force shall:

- (1) allow for public comment during at least one public meeting each year;
  - (2) vote in open session on recommendations made under

Section 34.005 to help reduce the incidence of pregnancy-related deaths and severe maternal morbidity in this state; and

(3) post public notice and minutes for meetings conducted for the sole purpose of reviewing cases for selection under Section 34.007.

SECTION \_\_\_\_. Section 34.009(d), Health and Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:

- (d) Information is not confidential under this section if the information is general information that cannot be connected with any specific individual, case, or health care provider, such as:
  - (1) total expenditures made for specified purposes;
- (2) the number of families served by particular health care providers or agencies;
  - (3) aggregated data on social and economic conditions;
- (4) medical data and information related to health care services that do not include any identifying information relating to a patient or the patient's family; [and]
- (5) <u>information</u>, <u>including the source</u>, <u>value</u>, <u>and</u> <u>purpose</u>, <u>related to gifts</u>, <u>grants</u>, <u>or donations to or for use by the task force</u>; <u>and</u>
  - (6) other statistical information.
