Amend SB 17 (house committee report) by adding the following appropriately numbered SECTION to the bill and renumbering subsequent SECTIONS of the bill accordingly:

SECTION ____. Section 34.002(b), Health and Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:

- (b) The task force is a multidisciplinary advisory committee within the department and is composed of the following $\underline{17}$ [$\underline{15}$] members:
- (1) $\underline{15}$ [$\underline{13}$] members appointed by the commissioner as follows:
- (A) four physicians specializing in obstetrics, at least one of whom is a maternal fetal medicine specialist;
 - (B) one certified nurse-midwife;
 - (C) one registered nurse;
 - (D) one nurse specializing in labor and delivery;
- (E) one physician specializing in family
 practice;
- $\underline{\text{(F)}}$ [$\overline{\text{(E)}}$] one physician specializing in psychiatry;
- $\underline{\text{(G)}}$ [$\overline{\text{(F)}}$] one physician specializing in pathology;
- $\underline{\text{(H)}}$ [$\frac{\text{(G)}}{\text{(G)}}$] one epidemiologist, biostatistician, or researcher of pregnancy-related deaths;
- $\underline{\text{(I)}} \ \ [\text{(H)}] \quad \text{one social worker or social service}$ provider;
- $\underline{\text{(J)}} \ \ [\frac{\text{(I)}}{\text{)}}] \quad \text{one community advocate in a relevant}$ field; [and]
- $\underline{\text{(K)}} \ [\text{(J)}] \ \text{one medical examiner or coroner}$ responsible for recording deaths; and
 - (L) one physician specializing in critical care;
- (2) a representative of the department's family and community health programs; and
- (3) the state epidemiologist for the department or the epidemiologist's designee.
