Amend H.B. No. 21 by adding the following appropriately 1 2 numbered SECTION to the bill and renumbering subsequent SECTIONS of the bill accordingly: 3 On Page 26, line 10 add a new Section 33 and renumber the 4 remaining sections appropriately. 5 6 SECTION 33. Study on weights, allotments, efficiencies 7 operation of schools. TEXAS COMMISSION ON SCHOOL DISTRICT FUNDING, WEIGHTS, 8 (1)9 ALLOTMENTS, OPERATIONS AND EFFICIENCY. (a) The Texas Commission on School District Funding, Weights, 10 Allotments, Operations and Efficiency is established to 11 develop and make recommendations for a new system of 12 funding and operation of Texas schools. 13 (b) The Commission is composed of 15 members, consisting 14 of the following: 15 four members appointed by the governor; 16 three members appointed by the lieutenant governor; (2) 17 three members appointed by the speaker of the house 18 (3) 19 of representatives; the chair of the senate committee on education, or a (4) 20 representative designated by the chair; 21 the chair of the senate committee on higher 22 (5) education, or a representative designated by the 23 chair; 24 (6) the chair of the house of representatives committee 25 on public education, or a representative designated 26 by the chair; 27

- on higher education, or a representative designated
- 3 by the chair;
- 4 (8) a member of the State Board of Education, as
- 5 designated by the chair of the board
- 6 (c) In making appointments under Subsections (b) (1),
- 7 (2), and (3) the governor, lieutenant governor and
- 8 speaker of the house of representatives shall coordinate
- 9 to ensure that the commission includes at least one of
- 10 each of the following representatives:
- 11 (1) a parent or person standing in parental relation to a
- 12 student enrolled in the public school system;
- 13 (2) an educator in the public school system;
- 14 (3) a member of the business community
- 15 (4) a member of the civic community
- 16 (5) a member of an organization affected by the operation
- 17 of school year operations
- 18 (6) a researcher on school finance and the operation of
- 19 schools
- 20 (7) a leader in research concerning the operation of
- 21 schools in other states and countries
- 22 PRESIDING OFFICER. The governor shall designate the presiding
- 23 officer of the commission.
- 24 COMPENSATION AND REIMBUSEMENT. A member of the commission is
- 25 not entitled to compensation for service on the commission but
- 26 it entitled for reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses
- 27 incurred in performing commission duties.
- 28 ADMINTRATIVE SUPPORT AND FUNDING.
- 29 (a) Staff members of the agency shall provide administrative
- 30 support for the commission.

- Funding for the administrative and operational expenses 1 of the commission shall be provided to the agency for 2 that purpose. 3 The commission shall develop recommendations RECOMMENDATIONS. 4 under this subchapter to address: 5 The purpose of the funding system of pubic 6 (1) education including foundational support as well 7 as categorical programs and targeted funding. 8 The appropriate level of funding based on (2) 9 demographics, geography and costs of education in 10 various parts of the state. 11 (3) Equity of funding among and within school 12 districts. 13 (4) School facilities funding 14 The appropriate level of state funding as well as (5) 15 local school district funding 16 (6) Promotion of innovation as well as advanced 17 academic learning and college readiness 18 (7) Recommendations on school district operations 19 including the school calendar, first and last 20 dates of instruction. 21 (8) School district operating costs and mechanisms to 22 improve school district efficiencies. 23 REPORT. The commission shall report recommendations to the 24 governor, lieutenant governor and speaker of the house of 25
- 27 COMMISSION ABOLISHED. The Commission is abolished January 1,
- 28 2019. This Subchapter expires January 1, 2019.
