A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the salary paid to certain professional employees of 3 public schools; making an appropriation.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 21.402, Education Code, is amended by 6 amending Subsections (c) and (g) and adding Subsections (c-2), 7 (c-3), and (d) to read as follows:

(c) The salary factors per step are as follows:

19 (c-2) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), for the 2017-2018 20 school year, a classroom teacher, full-time librarian, full-time 21 school counselor certified under Subchapter B, or full-time school 22 nurse is entitled to a monthly salary that is at least equal to the 23 sum of:

24 (1) the monthly salary the employee would have

received for the 2017-2018 school year under the district's salary 1 schedule for the 2016-2017 school year, if that schedule had been in 2 effect for the 2017-2018 school year, including any local 3 supplement and any money representing a career ladder supplement 4 5 the employee would have received in the 2017-2018 school year; and 6 (2) \$100. 7 (c-3) Subsection (c-2) and this subsection expire September 8 1, 2018. (d) A classroom teacher, full-time librarian, full-time 9 school counselor certified under Subchapter B, or full-time school 10 nurse employed by a school district in the 2017-2018 school year is, 11 12 as long as the employee is employed by the same district, entitled to a salary that is at least equal to the salary the employee 13 14 received for the 2017-2018 school year. 15 (q) The commissioner may adopt rules to govern the application of this section, including rules that: 16

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(1) require the payment of a minimum salary under this section to a person employed in more than one capacity for which a minimum salary is provided and whose combined employment in those capacities constitutes full-time employment; and

(2) specify the credentials a person must hold to be considered a [speech pathologist or] school nurse under this section.

24 SECTION 2. Section 42.2513(a), Education Code, is amended 25 to read as follows:

(a) A school district, including a school district that isotherwise ineligible for state aid under this chapter, is entitled

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1 to state aid in an amount equal to the sum of:

2 (1) the product of \$500 multiplied by the number of 3 full-time district employees, other than administrators or 4 employees subject to the minimum salary schedule under Section 5 21.402; [and]

6 (2) <u>the product of \$1,000 multiplied by the number of</u>
7 <u>classroom teachers, full-time librarians, full-time school</u>
8 <u>counselors certified under Subchapter B, Chapter 21, and full-time</u>
9 <u>school nurses employed by the district; and</u>

10 <u>(3)</u> the product of \$250 multiplied by the number of 11 part-time district employees, other than administrators.

SECTION 3. (a) In addition to other amounts appropriated in 12 S.B. 1, Acts of the 85th Legislature, Regular Session, 2017 (the 13 14 General Appropriations Act), to the Texas Education Agency for the 15 state fiscal biennium ending August 31, 2019, \$848,000,000 is appropriated from the economic stabilization fund to the agency for 16 17 use by the agency during the state fiscal biennium ending August 31, 2019, in supporting salary increases as provided by Section 21.402, 18 19 Education Code, as amended by this Act.

(b) It is the intent of the legislature that out of theappropriations made under Subsection (a) of this section:

(1) the Texas Education Agency transfer to the Teacher
Retirement System of Texas an amount of \$63,000,000 as the state's
contribution towards retirement benefits under Chapter 824,
Government Code, and health benefit plan coverage under the Texas
Public School Employees Group Insurance Program authorized by
Chapter 1575, Insurance Code; and

H.B. No. 24 (2) each professional public school employee subject 1 to the minimum salary schedule under Section 21.402, Education 2 3 Code, receive a salary increase. 4 SECTION 4. Section 21.402(c-1), Education Code, is 5 repealed. 6 SECTION 5. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018 7 school year. SECTION 6. (a) Subject to Subsection (b) of this section: 8 9 (1) this Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution; and 11 if this Act does not receive the vote necessary for 12 (2) immediate effect, this Act takes effect on the 91st day after the 13 14 last day of the legislative session. 15 (b) This Act takes effect only if it receives a vote of 16 two-thirds of the members present in each house of the legislature,

17 as provided by Section 49-g(m), Article III, Texas Constitution.
