## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to reimbursement rates for Medicaid acute care therapy
- 3 services; making an appropriation.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. (a) In addition to other amounts appropriated to
- 6 the Health and Human Services Commission for the state fiscal
- 7 biennium ending August 31, 2019, the following amounts are
- 8 appropriated to the commission for Medicaid acute care therapy
- 9 services for the specified periods:
- 10 (1) \$34,180,000 from the economic stabilization fund
- 11 and \$44,977,018 from federal funds for the state fiscal year ending
- 12 August 31, 2018; and
- 13 (2) \$35,995,000 from the economic stabilization fund
- 14 and \$48,262,959 from federal funds for the state fiscal year ending
- 15 August 31, 2019.
- 16 (b) It is the intent of the legislature that:
- 17 (1) the Health and Human Services Commission allocate
- 18 money appropriated under Subsection (a) of this section among
- 19 provider types and procedure codes for Medicaid acute care therapy
- 20 services in a manner that preserves access to care for clients
- 21 served under the Medicaid fee-for-service and managed care delivery
- 22 models; and
- 23 (2) money appropriated under Subsection (a) of this
- 24 section be fully reflected in reimbursement rates paid to Medicaid

- 1 acute care therapy services providers under both the Medicaid
- 2 fee-for-service and managed care delivery models.
- 3 SECTION 2. (a) Subject to Subsection (b) of this section:
- 4 (1) this Act takes effect immediately if it receives a
- 5 vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution; and
- 7 (2) if this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 8 immediate effect, this Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
- 9 last day of the legislative session.
- 10 (b) This Act takes effect only if it receives a vote of
- 11 two-thirds of the members present in each house of the legislature,
- 12 as provided by Section 49-g(m), Article III, Texas Constitution.
