Section 34.002(b), Health and Safety Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (b) The task force is a multidisciplinary advisory committee within the department and is composed of the following $\underline{16}$ 8 9 [15] members: 14 $[\frac{13}{2}]$ members appointed by the commissioner as 10 11 follows: 12 (A) four physicians specializing in obstetrics, at least one of whom is a maternal fetal medicine specialist; 13 14 (B) one certified nurse-midwife; one registered nurse; 15 (C) 16 (D) one nurse specializing in labor and delivery; 17 (E) one physician specializing in family practice; 18 (F) [(E)] physician specializing 19 one in psychiatry; 20 21 (G) [(F)] physician specializing in one 22 pathology;

- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 16 legislative session.
