3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 193.001, Health and Safety Code, is
5	amended by adding Subsection (a-2) to read as follows:
6	(a-2) In prescribing the form and contents of death
7	certificates, the department shall require each death certificate
8	to indicate whether a female decedent was pregnant at the time of
9	death or was pregnant at any time in the year preceding the
10	decedent's death.
11	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
12	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
13	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
14	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

15 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the

16 legislative session.
