- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 775.022(e), Health and Safety Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (e) The amount of compensation under Subsection (c) shall be
- 9 determined by multiplying the district's total indebtedness at the
- 10 time of the annexation by a fraction:
- 11 (1) the numerator of which is the assessed value of the
- 12 property to be annexed based on the most recent certified county
- 13 property tax rolls at the time of annexation plus the total amount
- 14 of the district's sales and use tax revenue collected by businesses
- 15 located in the property to be annexed in the 12 months preceding the
- 16 date of annexation, as reported by the comptroller; and
- 17 (2) the denominator of which is the total assessed
- 18 value of the property of the district based on the most recent
- 19 certified county property tax rolls at the time of annexation plus
- 20 the total amount of the district's sales and use tax revenue
- 21 collected by businesses located in the district in the 12 months
- 22 preceding the date of annexation, as reported by the comptroller.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect December 1, 2017.
