5	SECTION 1. Sections 42.103(b) and (d), Education Code, are
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(b) The basic allotment of a school district that [contains
8	at least 300 square miles and] has not more than 1,600 students in
9	average daily attendance is adjusted by applying the formula:
10	$AA = (1 + ((1,600 - ADA) \times .0004)) \times ABA$
11	(d) The basic allotment of a school district that offers a
12	kindergarten through grade 12 program and has less than 5,000

- 11 (d) The basic allotment of a school district that offers a 12 kindergarten through grade 12 program and has less than 5,000 13 students in average daily attendance is adjusted by applying the 14 formula, of the following formulas, that results in the greatest 15 adjusted allotment:
- 16 (1) the formula in Subsection (b), if [or (c) for 17 which] the district is eligible for that formula; or
- 18 (2) $AA = (1 + ((5,000 ADA) \times .000025)) \times ABA.$
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 42.103(c), Education Code, is repealed.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2018.
