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- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 51.9364 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 51.9364. CERTAIN DISCIPLINARY NOTATIONS REQUIRED ON
- 9 STUDENT TRANSCRIPTS. (a) In this section, "postsecondary
- 10 <u>educational institution" means an institution of higher education</u>
- 11 or a private or independent institution of higher education, as
- 12 those terms are defined by Section 61.003.
- 13 (b) If a postsecondary educational institution suspends or
- 14 expels a student from the institution for any reason, the
- 15 institution shall include on the student's transcript a
- 16 disciplinary notation stating that the student was suspended or
- 17 expelled, as applicable, from the institution.
- 18 (c) If a student withdraws from a postsecondary educational
- 19 <u>institution pending disciplinary charges that may result in the</u>
- 20 student's suspension or expulsion from the institution, the
- 21 institution may not end the disciplinary process until the
- 22 <u>institution makes a final determination of responsibility</u>,
- 23 including, if applicable, a determination of whether to suspend or
- 24 expel the student from the institution as a result. If the

- 1 institution suspends or expels the student from the institution,
- 2 the institution shall include a disciplinary notation on the
- 3 student's transcript stating that the student was suspended or
- 4 expelled, as applicable, from the institution.
- 5 (d) On request by the student, a postsecondary educational
- 6 institution may remove from a student's transcript a disciplinary
- 7 notation indicating the student's suspension or expulsion, as
- 8 applicable, from the institution if the institution determines
- 9 that:
- 10 (1) each condition of the suspension has been
- 11 fulfilled, if applicable; or
- 12 (2) good cause exists to remove the notation.
- (e) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall
- 14 adopt rules as necessary to implement this section.
- 15 SECTION 2. The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board
- 16 shall adopt the rules required by Section 51.9364, Education Code,
- 17 as added by this Act, as soon as practicable after this Act takes
- 18 effect.
- 19 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies
- 20 beginning with the 2018 spring semester.
- 21 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 25 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 26 legislative session.
