## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to a strategic plan to address postpartum depression.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 32, Health and Safety
5	Code, is amended by adding Section 32.046 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 32.046. POSTPARTUM DEPRESSION STRATEGIC PLAN. (a) In
7	this section, "postpartum depression" means a disorder with
8	postpartum onset that is categorized as a mood disorder by the
9	American Psychiatric Association in the Diagnostic and Statistical
10	Manual of Mental Disorders, 5th Edition (DSM-5), or a subsequent
11	edition adopted by rule by the executive commissioner.
12	(b) The executive commissioner shall develop and the
13	department shall implement a five-year strategic plan to improve
14	access to postpartum depression screening, referral, treatment,
15	and support services. Not later than September 1 of the last fiscal
16	year in each five-year period, the executive commissioner shall
17	develop a new strategic plan for the next five fiscal years
18	beginning with the following fiscal year.
19	(c) The strategic plan required under this section must
20	<pre>provide strategies to:</pre>
21	(1) increase awareness among state-administered
22	program providers who may serve women who are at risk of or are
23	experiencing postpartum depression about the prevalence and

24 effects of postpartum depression on outcomes for women and

- 1 <u>children;</u>
- 2 (2) establish a referral network of community-based
- 3 mental health providers and support services addressing postpartum
- 4 depression;
- 5 (3) increase women's access to formal and informal
- 6 peer support services, including access to certified peer
- 7 specialists who have received additional training related to
- 8 postpartum depression;
- 9 (4) raise public awareness of and reduce the stigma
- 10 related to postpartum depression; and
- 11 (5) leverage sources of funding to support existing
- 12 community-based postpartum depression screening, referral,
- 13 treatment, and support services.
- 14 (d) The executive commissioner shall coordinate with the
- 15 statewide health coordinating council, the office of mental health
- 16 coordination, and the statewide behavioral health coordinating
- 17 council in developing the strategic plan under this section.
- 18 (e) The executive commissioner shall update annually the
- 19 strategic plan developed under this section.
- SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2018, the executive
- 21 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall
- 22 develop the initial strategic plan required by Section 32.046,
- 23 Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 25 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 26 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 27 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

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1 Act takes effect December 1, 2017.
