6	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 531, Government Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 531.02222 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 531.02222. REPORT ON PROVIDERS PARTICIPATING IN
9	WOMEN'S HEALTH PROGRAMS. (a) In this section:
10	(1) "Breast and cervical cancer services program"
11	means a program operated by the commission that provides screening,
12	diagnostic, and other services related to breast and cervical
13	cancer to women in this state.
14	(2) "Family planning program" means a program operated
15	by the commission that provides health care and core family

- planning services to individuals in this state. 16 17 (3) "Texas women's health program" means a program
- operated by the commission that is substantially similar to the 18
- 19 demonstration project operated under former Section 32.0248, Human
- Resources Code, and that is intended to expand access to preventive 20
- 21 health and family planning services for women in this state.
- 22 (b) Not later than December 31 of each even-numbered year,
- 23 the commission shall prepare and submit a report to the legislature
- 24 on the registered provider locations participating in the breast

- 1 and cervical cancer services program, the family planning program,
- 2 and the Texas women's health program. The report must:
- 3 (1) cover the period beginning June 1 occurring three
- 4 years preceding the year in which the report is due and ending May
- 5 31 occurring the year before the year in which the report is due;
- 6 and
- 7 (2) include, for each registered provider location
- 8 during the period covered by the report:
- 9 (A) the number of physicians participating in
- 10 each program at that location;
- 11 (B) the number of individuals seen by each
- 12 physician participating in a program at that location and the
- 13 program in which the individuals were treated; and
- 14 (C) the number of times a specific individual was
- 15 treated at that location by a participating physician in each
- 16 program.
- 17 (c) If the breast and cervical cancer services program, the
- 18 family planning program, or the Texas women's health program is
- 19 consolidated with another program or otherwise modified, the
- 20 commission shall include in the report under Subsection (b) the
- 21 required information for each successor program that provides the
- 22 <u>same or similar services.</u>
- 23 <u>(d) The information provided under Subsection (b) may not</u>
- 24 include any personally identifying information about an
- 25 individual.
- SECTION 2. Not later than December 31, 2018, the Health and
- 27 Human Services Commission shall provide to the legislature the

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- 1 initial report for the period of June 1, 2015, through May 31, 2017,
- 2 as required by Section 531.02222, Government Code, as added by this
- 3 Act, notwithstanding Section 531.02222(b)(1), Government Code, as
- 4 added by this Act.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect December 1, 2017.
