- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 21.0442(b), Education Code, as added by
- 7 H.B. 3349, Acts of the 85th Legislature, Regular Session, 2017, is
- 8 amended to read as follows:
- 9 (b) A person is eligible for admission to an educator
- 10 preparation program created under this section only if the person:
- 11 (1) has been issued a high school diploma, a high
- 12 school equivalency certificate, or a postsecondary credential,
- 13 certificate, or degree;
- 14 (2) has seven years of full-time wage-earning
- 15 experience, including experience obtained while serving in the
- 16 <u>United States armed services</u>, within the preceding 10 years in an
- 17 approved occupation for which instruction is offered;
- 18 (3) holds with respect to that occupation a current
- 19 license, certificate, or registration, as applicable, issued by a
- 20 nationally recognized accrediting agency based on a recognized test
- 21 or measurement; and
- 22 (4) within the period described by Subdivision (2),
- 23 has not been the subject of a complaint filed with a licensing
- 24 entity or other agency that regulates the occupation of the person,

- 1 other than a complaint that was determined baseless or unfounded by
- 2 that entity or agency.
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect December 1, 2017.
