A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to an exemption from the sales tax for firearms and hunting
- 3 supplies for a limited period.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 151, Tax Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 151.358 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 151.358. FIREARMS AND HUNTING SUPPLIES FOR LIMITED
- 8 PERIOD. (a) In this section, "hunting supplies" means ammunition,
- 9 archery equipment, hunting blinds and stands, hunting decoys,
- 10 firearm cleaning supplies, gun cases and gun safes, hunting optics,
- 11 and hunting safety equipment.
- 12 (b) The sale of a firearm or hunting supplies is exempted
- 13 from the taxes imposed by this chapter if the sale takes place
- 14 during a period beginning at 12:01 a.m. on the Saturday of the last
- 15 full weekend in August and ending at 11:59 p.m. on the following
- 16 Sunday.
- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act does not
- 18 affect tax liability accruing before the effective date of this
- 19 Act. That liability continues in effect as if this Act had not been
- 20 enacted, and the former law is continued in effect for the
- 21 collection of taxes due and for civil and criminal enforcement of
- 22 the liability for those taxes.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect December 1, 2017.
