A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the salary paid to certain professional employees of
3	public schools; making an appropriation.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 21.402, Education Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsections (c-2), (c-3), and (d) and amending Subsection
7	(g) to read as follows:
8	(c-2) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), for the 2017-2018
9	school year, a classroom teacher, full-time librarian, full-time
10	school counselor certified under Subchapter B, or full-time school
11	nurse is entitled to a monthly salary that is at least equal to the
12	<pre>sum of:</pre>
13	(1) the monthly salary the teacher would have received
14	for the 2017-2018 school year under the district's salary schedule
15	for the 2016-2017 school year, if that schedule had been in effect
16	for the 2017-2018 school year, including any local supplement and
17	any money representing a career ladder supplement the teacher would
18	have received in the 2017-2018 school year; and
19	<u>(2) \$250.</u>
20	(c-3) Subsection (c-2) and this subsection expire September
21	<u>1, 2018.</u>
22	(d) A classroom teacher, full-time librarian, full-time
23	school counselor certified under Subchapter B, or full-time school

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nurse employed by a school district in the 2017-2018 school year is,

- 1 as long as the teacher is employed by the same district, entitled to
- 2 <u>a salary that is at least equal to the salary the teacher received</u>
- 3 for the 2017-2018 school year.
- 4 (g) The commissioner may adopt rules to govern the
- 5 application of this section, including rules that:
- 6 (1) require the payment of a minimum salary under this
- 7 section to a person employed in more than one capacity for which a
- 8 minimum salary is provided and whose combined employment in those
- 9 capacities constitutes full-time employment; and
- 10 (2) specify the credentials a person must hold to be
- 11 considered a [speech pathologist or] school nurse under this
- 12 section.
- SECTION 2. Section 42.2513(a), Education Code, is amended
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 (a) A school district, including a school district that is
- 16 otherwise ineligible for state aid under this chapter, is entitled
- 17 to state aid in an amount equal to the sum of:
- 18 (1) the product of \$500 multiplied by the number of
- 19 full-time district employees, other than administrators or
- 20 employees subject to the minimum salary schedule under Section
- 21 21.402; [and]
- 22 (2) the product of \$2,500 multiplied by the number of
- 23 <u>classroom teachers</u>, <u>full-time librarians</u>, <u>full-time school</u>
- 24 counselors certified under Subchapter B, Chapter 21, and full-time
- 25 school nurses employed by the district; and
- 26 (3) the product of \$250 multiplied by the number of
- 27 part-time district employees, other than administrators.

- 1 SECTION 3. The amount of \$2.5 billion is appropriated from
- 2 the economic stabilization fund to the foundation school fund for
- 3 distribution by the commissioner of education during the state
- 4 fiscal biennium beginning September 1, 2017, to school districts to
- 5 provide salary increases as provided by Section 42.2513, Education
- 6 Code, as amended by this Act.
- 7 SECTION 4. Section 21.402(c-1), Education Code, is
- 8 repealed.
- 9 SECTION 5. (a) Subject to Subsection (b) of this section:
- 10 (1) this Act takes effect immediately if it receives a
- 11 vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution; and
- 13 (2) if this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 14 immediate effect, this Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
- 15 last day of the legislative session.
- 16 (b) This Act takes effect only if it receives a vote of
- 17 two-thirds of the members present in each house of the legislature,
- 18 as provided by Section 49-g(m), Article III, Texas Constitution.
