A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to reporting teacher turnover information in the performance report of a public school district. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 39.306(a), Education Code, as effective 5 September 1, 2017, is amended to read as follows: 6 (a) Each board of trustees shall publish an annual report 7 describing the educational performance of the district and of each 8 campus in the district that includes uniform student performance 9 and descriptive information as determined under rules adopted by 10 11 the commissioner. The annual report must also include: 12 (1) campus performance objectives established under 13 Section 11.253 and the progress of each campus toward those 14 objectives, which shall be available to the public; 15 (2) information indicating the district's accreditation status and identifying each district campus awarded a 16 distinction designation under Subchapter G or considered an 17 unacceptable campus under Chapter 39A; 18 19 (3) the district's current special education 20 compliance status with the agency; 21 (4) a statement of the number, rate, and type of 22 violent or criminal incidents that occurred on each district campus, to the extent permitted under the Family Educational Rights 23 and Privacy Act of 1974 (20 U.S.C. Section 1232g); 24

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1 (e) The report may include the following information:

(1) student information, including total enrollment,
enrollment by ethnicity, socioeconomic status, and grade groupings
and retention rates;

5 (2) financial information, including revenues and 6 expenditures;

7 (3) staff information <u>in addition to the information</u> 8 <u>required under Subsection (a)(8)</u>, including number and type of 9 staff by sex, ethnicity, years of experience, and highest degree 10 held, <u>and</u> teacher and administrator salaries[, and teacher 11 <u>turnover</u>];

12 (4) program information, including student enrollment 13 by program, teachers by program, and instructional operating 14 expenditures by program; and

15 (5) the number of students placed in a disciplinary16 alternative education program under Chapter 37.

SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018school year.

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SECTION 4. This Act takes effect December 1, 2017.

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
