## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the exemption from ad valorem taxation of precious
- 3 metal held in the Texas Bullion Depository.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 11, Tax Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 11.141 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 11.141. PRECIOUS METAL HELD IN TEXAS BULLION
- 8 DEPOSITORY. (a) For purposes of this section, "precious metal" has
- 9 the meaning assigned by Section 2116.001, Government Code.
- 10 (b) A person is entitled to an exemption from taxation of
- 11 the precious metal that the person owns and that is held in the
- 12 Texas Bullion Depository established under Chapter 2116,
- 13 Government Code, regardless of whether the precious metal is held
- 14 or used by the person for the production of income.
- 15 (c) Notwithstanding Section 11.14(c), the governing body of
- 16 a taxing unit may not provide for the taxation of precious metal
- 17 exempted from taxation under Subsection (b).
- SECTION 2. Section 11.42(b), Tax Code, is amended to read as
- 19 follows:
- 20 (b) An exemption authorized by Section 11.11 or 11.141 is
- 21 effective immediately on qualification for the exemption.
- SECTION 3. Section 11.43(a), Tax Code, is amended to read as
- 23 follows:
- 24 (a) To receive an exemption, a person claiming the

- 1 exemption, other than an exemption authorized by Section 11.11,
- 2 11.12, 11.14, <u>11.141</u>, 11.145, 11.146, 11.15, 11.16, 11.161, or
- 3 11.25 [of this code], must apply for the exemption. To apply for an
- 4 exemption, a person must file an exemption application form with
- 5 the chief appraiser for each appraisal district in which the
- 6 property subject to the claimed exemption has situs.
- 7 SECTION 4. Section 11.141, Tax Code, as added by this Act,
- 8 applies only to a tax year beginning on or after January 1, 2019.
- 9 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect January 1, 2019, but only
- 10 if the constitutional amendment proposed by the 85th Legislature,
- 11 1st Called Session, 2017, authorizing the legislature to exempt
- 12 from ad valorem taxation precious metal held in the Texas Bullion
- 13 Depository is approved by the voters. If that amendment is not
- 14 approved by the voters, this Act has no effect.
