4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 531, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 531.0997 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 531.0997. TEXAS WOMEN'S HEALTH PROGRAM; REQUIRED
8	SERVICES FOR MENTAL HEALTH, BEHAVIORAL HEALTH, AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE.
9	(a) In this section, "Texas women's health program" means a program
10	operated by the commission that is substantially similar to the
11	demonstration project operated under former Section 32.0248, Human
12	Resources Code, and that is intended to expand access to preventive
13	health and family planning services for women in this state.
14	(b) The health care services provided under the Texas
15	women's health program must include screening and treatment for:
16	(1) mental health conditions;
17	(2) behavioral health conditions; and
18	(3) substance abuse disorders.
19	(c) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules necessary
20	to implement this section.
21	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect December 1, 2017.
