- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 21, Local Government Code,
- is amended by adding Section 21.006 to read as follows: 6
- Sec. 21.006. TERM LIMITS FOR GOVERNING BODY OF GENERAL-LAW 7
- MUNICIPALITY. (a) In this section: 8
- (1) "Governing body of a municipality" includes the 9
- presiding officer of the municipality's governing body. 10
- 11 (2) "Municipal term limit" means a limit on the number
- 12 of terms of service a member of the governing body of a municipality
- 13 may serve on the governing body.
- 14 (b) The governing body of a general-law municipality may
- order an election to impose, amend, or repeal municipal term 15
- 16 limits.
- (c) The ballot at an election for imposing municipal term 17
- limits must be printed to permit voting for or against the 18
- proposition: "Imposing term limits consisting of (insert number of 19
- terms and length of terms) on a person's service on the governing 20
- body of (insert name of municipality)." If a majority of the votes 21
- received at the election favor the proposition, the number of terms 22
- 23 a person may serve on the governing body is limited as provided in
- 24 the proposition.

(d) The ballot at an election for amending municipal term 1 limits must be printed to permit voting for or against the 2 proposition: "Amending municipal term limits to (insert "increase" 3 or "decrease") the number of terms a person may serve on the 4 governing body of (insert name of municipality) by providing for 5 term limits consisting of (insert number of terms and length of 6 terms) on the person's service on the governing body." 7 majority of the votes received at the election favor the 8

proposition, the number of terms a person may serve on the governing

body is limited as amended.

- 11 (e) The ballot at an election for repealing municipal term
 12 limits must be printed to permit voting for or against the
 13 proposition: "Repealing term limits for a person's service on the
 14 governing body of (insert name of municipality)." If a majority of
 15 the votes received at the election favor the proposition, the
 16 municipal term limits are repealed.
- (f) If less than a majority of the votes received at an election under Subsection (d) or (e) favor the applicable proposition, municipal term limits that existed before the election are not affected.
- 21 (g) A municipal term limit imposed or amended by an election 22 held under this section does not apply to a term that a member of the 23 governing body is serving or was elected or appointed to serve on or 24 before the date the election was held.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
