- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 85, Election Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 85.0631 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 85.0631. DAYS AND HOURS FOR VOTING: TEMPORARY BRANCH.
- 8 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), early voting by personal
- 9 appearance at a temporary branch polling place may be conducted on
- 10 any one or more days and during any hours of the period for early
- 11 voting by personal appearance, as determined by the authority
- 12 <u>establishing the branch.</u>
- (b) In an election in which the authority ordering the
- 14 election has established at least five temporary branch polling
- 15 places in the territory served by the early voting clerk, early
- 16 voting by personal appearance at no less than 80 percent of the
- 17 temporary branch polling places shall be conducted on the same days
- 18 and during the same hours as voting is conducted at the main early
- 19 voting polling place. For purposes of this subsection, a temporary
- 20 branch polling place does not include a temporary branch polling
- 21 place established at a church.
- (c) The authority authorized under Section 85.006 to order
- 23 <u>early voting on a Saturday or Sunday may order such voting at any</u>
- 24 temporary branch polling place that is not required to conduct

- 1 voting on the same days and during the same hours as voting is
- 2 conducted at the main early voting polling place under Subsection
- 3 (b).
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 85.068(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (a) The early voting clerk shall post notice for each
- 7 election stating any dates and the hours that voting on Saturday or
- 8 Sunday will be conducted at a temporary branch polling place [under
- 9 Section 85.064(d) or 85.065(b)], if the early voting clerk is a
- 10 county clerk or city secretary under Section 83.002 or 83.005.
- SECTION 3. Sections 85.064 and 85.065, Election Code, are
- 12 repealed.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect December 1, 2017.
